



24 and 25 July—Save the date!



The Strasbourg company Les Ombres des Soirs has been travelling rural France with its exalted theatrical adaptation of the satirical novel by George Orwell. A show with a highly contagious collective energy! The animal farm takes on a salutary and jubilant character at a time when being in a community poses questions to all of us. Created in a collective spirit, the show with its thrifty scenography goes straight to the point and to the heart by resting essentially on the intrepidity of its actors. Tired by the ill-treatment suffered, the animals of "La Ferme du Manoir" revolted and chased their master from his domain, which they renamed for the occasion "La Ferme des animaux". Freed from oppression, the animals then establish the laws that will govern their Republic. With black humor as its vector, the political fable of George Orwell is a hard-hitting denunciation of



any authoritarian regime, but also of the weakness of men. Closer to the spectators, the young troupe of seven actors share much more than an incisive denunciation!

Le Poussin en Goguette !

For the occasion, the GABOL association has decided to wake up its Poussin.

It has been decided that this summer: The Poussin goes to Goguette! the area near the mayor's office at L'humeau de Bray has been reserved on the July 24 and 25 and it will be converted to look like a tavern from 6 p.m on. School : RPI St Macaire – Les Verchers (Doué en Anjou)


This rather unusual school year ended on July 4 after only 3 weeks of "almost normal" operation. We are now preparing for the start of the new year, hoping for better circumstances. We hope that the efforts made by the children, teaching staff and municipal team (ATSEM, household, daycare and canteen officers) have not been in vain! In the mean time, we wish you all a relaxing and "rejuvenating" holiday!

The start of the new school year will be Tuesday September 1st welcoming the 114 students of the RPI:

- Kindergarten classes (Small, medium and large sections) and CP and part of CE1 in St Macaire, a total of 65 students
- The classes of CE1-CE2 and CM1-CM2 at Verchers sur Layon, 49 students

Enrollment this year, which is slightly up compared to previous years, means that we can keep the fifth classroom that was opened in 2016 while also providing stability of the teaching staff.

The only change in the teaching team is Ms. Coendo, a CM teacher and director of the Verchers site. She leaves her post after 5 years. We wish her all the best and hope that she enjoys her new role.



Chaired by Sabrina Chalopin, the APE experienced some difficulties fulfilling its missions ... namely to support the teachers in their educational projects (raising funds to help purchase equipment and school trips).

The pupils of the CE and CM (Les Verchers) classes should have gone on a discovery trip to the sea in May. In addition to everyone's disappointment and frustration, the financial impact for the association was not trivial (payment of the reception structure without insurance for a future reimbursement and events of the spring, the end of the year party (usually fruitful) were all cancelled.


We invite ALL Macairois to support the EPA this year. Next event, paper collection will be starting November 13, 2020!

Information COVID-19

Our world has been experiencing an unprecedented crisis for more than 6 months. Although COVID-19 is often manifested as a mild lung condition, it can also affect us a lot harder, and it has spread to our homes. This condition can be mitigated if we take certain precautions:



- Barrier gestures, (avoid kissing and handshaking, wash your hands regularly and if this is not possible, use hydroalcoholic gel)
- Wear a mask when it is not possible to social distance (France recommends 1 meter minimum between each person)

Our village of Saint Macaire has so far been spared of infection. (We have no known cases).

Our commune adapted and continued to live a normal life. The outgoing team provided good continuity while the new team transitioned in. Some maintenance work has been completed. We were even able to distribute protective masks to all villagers!

Following the end of confinement on May 11, the team at our school has been able to gradually welcome back our children. A big thank you goes to them for this commitment.

Unfortunately, public activities in the town were cancelled (Easter egg hunt, school party, etc), but St Macaire du Bois is coming back to life. We will soon be able to take part in new events. Keep an eye out on your mailboxes!
